### Contact with Parents

Every girl and boy will normally be able to phone home on arrival at the chalet. However if the party arrives very late due to delays on the flight the children may be asked to phone the following day. The school will be notified of their safe arrival so assume that "no news is good news".

Please could phone calls into the chalet be limited to matters of necessity. Contact from children is normally made by post or e-mail. The children will have the opportunity to phone their parents every 3 or 4 days, but parents should not be too worried if they don't as they may be very happy and busy doing all sorts of exciting things.
